2014 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The Cabernet Sauvignon grapes destined for this wine are handpicked from our estate vineyards in the skyscraper heights of the Uco Valley in Mendoza. Vines in this region face harsh winters and warm summers with mild days and very cold nights. The vines are planted in a rocky, sandy loam with medium to low fertility, good drainage, and low organic material content.

An intense ruby red, our Cabernet Sauvignon displays lovely aromas of ripe red fruits including currant and black cherry, and subtle hints of licorice, black pepper and cumin. Notes of tobacco and chocolate greet you just before you sip. Sweet and robust tannins give this wine good volume in the mouth, accentuated by intense and spicy flavors that mirror the nose. These flavors linger on the long, pleasant finish.
